Simon Bailey was employed as a freelance interim revenues and benefits manager for the Unity Partnership from April 2009 to December 2009. He served in the post of Director of Exchequer Services and Access Oldham and reported directly to me as Managing Director.

During his time in Unity, Simon worked extremely well with colleagues from both the partnership and Oldham Council.
